In this course, students will explore the loveable Pixar characters and funny, emotional, and organic storytelling. Students will be encouraged to express their narrative voices as they dig deep, and identify with important life lessons. They will explore 'The Story Spine': Pixar's 4th rule of storytelling, to build stronger stories with 7 sentences.

Caldecott Award Book Club



The Caldecott Award annually recognizes the most distinguished, beautifully illustrated, American picture books. In the Book Club, students will use these award-winning works of literature to further develop their burgeoning language, comprehension and creativity skills, while building a love of literature.

Fun Fundamentals



Fun Fundamentals is a personalised review and extension of the groundwork skills necessary to be a successful reader and writer in kindergarten and the early years of primary. Each child will have a tailored set of activities designed to reinforce and strengthen key skills in decoding, comprehension, and written composition.

Storytime Yoga



This is a great opportunity to incorporate movement while developing speaking and listening skills! Students will learn to structure stories with character, setting, problem and solution. They will bring these stories to life with yoga poses. By practicing yoga poses, children can learn how to exercise, develop confidence, and concentrate better.

Beyond the Basics



Beyond the Basics is a personalized review and extension of the groundwork skills necessary to be a successful reader and writer in the first and second grades. ENGLISH G1-2

Creating Storybooks

In this course, students will craft their personal narrative in the form of an illustrated storybook that can be treasured and shared with others. They will also be guided through interactive and creative tasks to help them create the books.

The Power of Descriptions

Don't Forget to Have FUNdamentals



Mystery Stories



Reading, summarizing, and writing are all important English skills, but the basic fundamentals: structure, grammar, spelling, punctuation are often left behind. This week-long course will have these fundamentals in the forefront by focusing on different "dress up" stylistic techniques, so all students can learn how to independently create upgraded sentences.

In this bite-sized edition of our regular term course, students will put on their detective hats to read, solve, and write their own mystery stories. Students will build content vocabulary, put together evidence to find out "whodunnit?", and practice critical thinking skills.

Beyond the Five-Paragraph



Essay

Write like a pro! Real essays don't follow the formula taught in schools. In fact, they break the rules! The word 'essay' means to try. It follows a writer's curiosity about a topic, meanders, digresses, and ultimately discovers something unexpected about the topic, and the writer.

(For advanced writers only, who are already familiar with the rules.)

Building with Math

There is a reason math teachers around the world have begun using "manipulatives" in their math classes: young students learn more through their hands than from words. By building, students have fun learning about materials and design, all while practicing their math skills in physical and meaningful ways.

Engineering Stories

Constructing marble runs from card stock teaches kids how to take two dimensional ideas and create three dimensional objects that are stable structures. Then, like a book report, students will "map" the story in ramps so the path of the marble mimics the storyline.

Artistic Coder

With the rise of teamLab, we can see how code has the power to produce beautiful, visual creations. This course is designed not just for the logical, but also students who love using their brushes. We will take a peek at how we can make use of mathematical equations to paint animated GIFs!

Life in Code

Life in Code is an in-depth look at how patterns run our daily lives. We will use basic block-based coding to reflect on the steps we take when eating, working, sleeping, etc. Students will be taking apart their habits, translating their daily patterns into codeable stories.

Minecraft Electronics

In this course, we will be focusing on redstones, a group of specialized blocks in Minecraft that emulates real life circuitry. Combining basic electronics concepts and Minecraft physics, students will be designing their own digital puzzles and contraption mechanisms to make their very own obstacle course!

Circuits and Coding

This is a hands-on course in which students create circuits to power lights and fans, art with lights, various robots, and memorabilia such as infinity photo cubes. The course can be customized to be hardware engineering, software engineering, or a mix of both, depending on the students' interests.

PUBLIC SPEAKING

G1-4

Finding Your Voice

Considered to be one of the most fundamental and widely applicable skills, public speaking can be honed through practice, guidance, and inspiration - what we hope to provide. This course helps students become more confident when speaking in public and in interviews. Students will role play while improving their technique in speaking. They will also analyze, produce, and perform a range of text types.

G5-6

Speak as an Expert

As students progress into secondary school, they are increasingly asked to make presentations in class. In this course, students will do research on a topic of their choosing, write a speech, and learn to deliver it like an expert. At the end of the course, they will be able to deliver their own informative speech in front of an audience.

創意寫作班

集中拼音教學,使學生快速、準確的掌握拼音。每堂課設有音節練習、聲調練習、視讀練習等等,運用各種活動、互動遊戲等形式增加學習樂趣,課程還設有期中和期末綜合練習,可用於測試評估和複習鞏固。
